

## KIRKHILL DISTRICT AMENITIES ASSOCIATION

### CHILD PROTECTION POLICY

The Kirkhill District Amenities Association (hereafter called 'the Association') aims to ensure that all children are protected and kept safe from harm while they are with groups or clubs using the community hall and associated facilities.

The Association recognises that child protection should not be treated in isolation and in accordance with guidance given by the Highland Council Child Protection Committee, has the following procedures in place to ensure that all groups/clubs working with children and young people have an up to date Child Protection Policy in place:

- A copy of the Child Protection Policy shall be on public display in the community hall, with copies being available as required.
- The Association maintains a register of all relevant groups/clubs using the community hall and facilities, which is reviewed annually.
- All relevant groups/clubs are required to confirm to the Secretary that they have an appropriate child protection policy in place; at the time of initial contact and thereafter on an annual basis.
- If required, copies of an appropriate child protection policy written in accordance with the guidance given by the Highland Child Protection Committee are available from the Secretary.
